The Registrar may refuse to issue an instructor's licence to a person if during the 5 years immediately preceding the application date, (i) the person was convicted of an offence under the Criminal Code (Canada) that is related to the functions, duties or business of a driving instructor, including, without limitation, the offences of forgery, the use of false pretenses, bribery, extortion, conspiracy to defraud or theft or an offence involving moral turpitude or the unlawful operation of a vehicle, and (ii) the conviction is final by reason of the expiry of the time for appeal without the appeal's having been made or the final disposition of the appeal by the courts. The Registrar must refuse to issue an instructor's licence to a person if (a) the person's operator's licence has been suspended or cancelled during the 2 years immediately preceding the application date, or (b) the person has accumulated 7 or more demerit points under the Use of Highway and Rules of the Road Regulation when the application is made.
