

NORTHWEST TERRITORIES GDL: MOTORCYCLES

PROGRAM INFORMATION

To obtain a motorcycle licence in the NWT, there are three GDL stages to complete:
 Stage 1 – Class 7 (Learner);
 Stage 2 – Class 6P (Novice); and
 Stage 3 – Class 6 (Full licence).
 Effective date of program implementation: June 1, 2005

LEARNER LICENCE: Stage 1 – Class 7
 Motorcycle

NOVICE LICENCE: Stage 2 – Class 6P
 Motorcycle

NOVICE LICENCE: Stage 3 – Full Class 6
 Motorcycle

AGE RESTRICTIONS

- Minimum entry age: 15 years
- Minimum exit age: 16 years

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Vision test
- Written knowledge test
- Parental consent
- Driver education: Voluntary

EXIT REQUIREMENTS

- Time completion: Hold a Class 7 licence for 12 months suspension free
- Successfully pass practical road examination

STAGE DURATION

- Minimum duration: 12 months
- Maximum holding period

SUPERVISORY DRIVER

- Age: 18+ years old
- Licence held: Full Class 5
- Time licensed: At least 2 years
- BAC level while supervising: The instructor must have no alcohol or drugs in system
- Location of the supervisor: In front passenger seat

SUPERVISED DRIVING

- Minimum amount of supervised driving

DRIVING RESTRICTIONS AND CONDITIONS

- BAC level while driving: Zero
- Night driving: Not permitted to drive between 11p.m. and 6a.m.
- Passenger restrictions: A Learner cannot have any passengers other than the supervisor

SUSPENSION/PROHIBITION

- Lower demerit points: Accumulation of 6 or more demerit points, the Registrar shall suspend the driver's licence.

DRIVER IMPROVEMENT ACTIONS

- Minimum entry age: 16 years
- Minimum exit age: 17 years

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Time completion: Held a Class 7 or valid operator's licence for 12 months suspension free
- Successfully pass a written knowledge test
- Successfully pass a practical road test

EXIT REQUIREMENTS

- Time completion: Hold a Class 6P licence for 12 months suspension free

STAGE DURATION

- Minimum duration: 12 months
- Maximum holding period
