

# NUNAVUT GDL: PASSENGER VEHICLES

## PROGRAM INFORMATION

There is currently no GDL program in Nunavut. To operate a passenger vehicle, applicants must first obtain a Class 7 learner licence.

## LEARNER LICENCE: CLASS 7

### AGE RESTRICTIONS

- Minimum entry age: 15 years
- Minimum exit age: 16 years

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Vision test
- Knowledge test
- Parental consent
- Driver education: Voluntary

### EXIT REQUIREMENTS

- Time completion: 4 weeks as a Class 7 driver
- Successfully pass test/course: Class 5 road test

### STAGE DURATION

- Minimum duration: 4 weeks
- Maximum holding period

### SUPERVISORY DRIVER

- Age
- Licence held
- Time licensed
- BAC level while supervising
- Driver log
- Location of the supervisor

### SUPERVISED DRIVING

- Minimum amount of supervised driving

### DRIVING RESTRICTIONS AND CONDITIONS

- BAC level while driving
- Night driving
- Passenger restrictions
- Road restrictions
- Display "L" sign/plate when driving
- Other restrictions

### SUSPENSION/PROHIBITION

- Lower driver penalty point threshold

### DRIVER IMPROVEMENT ACTIONS
