<sup>1</sup> If drivers complete the requirements, they will have the following endorsements added to their driver's licence: A – Valid for the operation of any motor vehicle; or D – Valid for motorcycles with engines of 100 cc's or less

<sup>2</sup> After 14 days, drivers can take the Motorcycle Skills Test; after 30 days they can take the Class 6 road test

<sup>3</sup> Must hold Learner licence for 3 months, reduced to 1 month if an approved motorcycle training course is taken

<sup>4</sup> 1 year before having to re-qualify for licence (by taking the vision, knowledge and motorcycle skills tests again)

<sup>5</sup> Driver must always ride within sight of a qualified supervisor – requirement removed after successful completion of MST

<sup>6</sup> No night driving; only permitted to ride during daylight hours, between sunrise and sunset

<sup>7</sup> Must not exceed 60 km/h - restriction removed after successful completion of MST

<sup>8</sup> Subject to the prohibition level of other experienced drivers (at the 15-19 penalty points level)

<sup>9</sup> If driver completes an approved motorcycle training course, the chief instructor will stamp their licence with "LM"; the driver will not be examined by a driver enhancement officer because both practical tests were included in the training program
